

Anesha Crochet Lace Scarf



The written instructions for this pattern use English terminology but the pattern is also shown in chart form

Materials

2 x 100gm skeins of chunky Baby Alpaca from www.knitting4fun.com

8.0mm crochet hook

Abbreviations

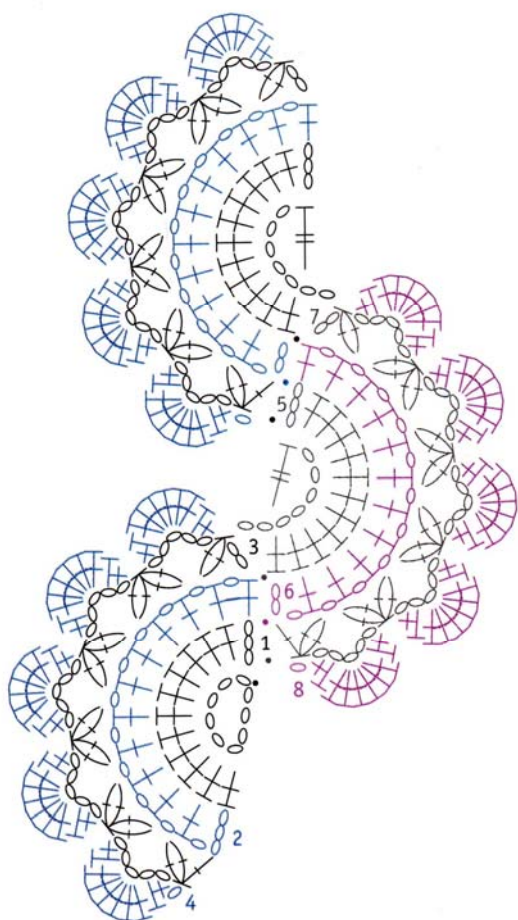
hk – hook; **lp** – loop, **ch** – chain; **tr** – treble; **htr** – half treble; **dc** – double crochet; **ss** – slip stitch; **ch-sp** – chain space; **dtr** – double treble;

4 tr-cl – 4 treble cluster worked as follows – **yo, insert hk into st indicated and pull up lp, yo, pull through 2 lps on hk, rep from * once in same st and twice in next st indicated, yo and pull through all lps on hk;*

3 tr-cl – 3 treble cluster worked as follows - **yo, insert hk into st indicated and pull up lp, yo, pull through 2 lps on hk, rep from * once in same st and once in next st indicated, yo and pull through all lps on hk.*

2 tr-cl – 2 trble cluster worked as follows - **yo, insert hk into st indicated and pull up lp, yo, pull through 2 lps on hk, rep from * once more in same st, yo and pull through all lps on hk.*

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Ch9, sl st to first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: (RS) ch3, 11tr in ring, turn.

Row 2: ch4, [tr, ch1] in each tr and then 1tr into 3rd ch of turning ch.

Row 3: ch2, skip 1 ch1-sp, 2tr-cl in next ch1-sp, *ch5, 4tr-cl over ch1-sp previous cluster worked in and ch1-sp 2 away i.e. skipping 1 ch1-sp,* rep from * to * across to last ch1-sp, ch5, 3tr-cl in ch1-sp previous cluster worked in and 3rd ch of turning chain, turn.

Row 4: ch1, [dc, htr, 6tr, htr, dc] in each ch5-sp to the end of the row

Next Motif

Row 5: ch7, dtr in 5th ch from hk, ch3, 11tr in ring, sl st to edge of previous motif (top of [tr,1ch] row)

Row 6: ch2, sl st to edge of previous motif (11 tr row), turn, ch1, [tr, ch1] into each tr across the row – 11 times.

Row 7: ch2, skip 1 ch1-sp, 2tr-cl in next ch1-sp, *ch5, 4tr-cl over ch1-sp previous cluster worked in and ch1-sp 2 away i.e. skipping 1 ch1-sp,* rep from * to * across to last ch1-sp, ch5, 3tr-cl in ch1-sp previous cluster worked in and turning ch/sl st join to

previous motif of the previous row, turn

Row 8: ch1, [dc, htr, 6tr, ht, dc] in each ch5-sp to the end of the row.

Repeat **Next Motif** for the desired length.

If you want to link the motifs on the outer edge at the beginning of **Row 8** ch1, dc, htr, work a dc through the htr of the edge shell from the previous motif on that side and then continue to complete the shell i.e. 6tr, htr, dc. This will link for example motifs 1 and 3.

In the scarf I worked 4 motifs before starting to link them i.e. motif 5 was linked to motif 3.
