

Fingerless chevron mittens

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Size

Adult medium size hand

Materials

Col A 1 x 50gm ball Rowan Felted Tweed or DK yarn

Col B 1 x 50gm ball Rowan Tapestry or DK yarn

One pair 4mm needles

Tension 10sts and 23 rows to **5cm**

Abbreviations

Inc – increase by knitting into the front and back of the next stitch; k2tog – knit 2 together; skpo – slip 1 knit 1 pass slip stitch over; yo – yarn over needle; p2tog – purl 2 together; pm – place stitch marker; sm – slip marker from left to right needle

Right mitten

Using Col A and 4mm needles cast on 42sts

K12, pm, k30

Knit 1 row

Continue in pattern as follows,

Row 1: k1, inc, k8, k2tog, sm, skpo, k10, inc, k17

Row 2: knit

Row 3: Col B k2, *yo, skpo,* repeat to last 2 stitches, k2

Row 4: p2 *yo, p2tog,* repeat to last 2 stitches, p2

Row 5 and 6: Col A knit

Repeat these 6 rows until the knitting measures 9.5cm finishing after a **Row 2**.

Change to k2, p2 rib (Col A) and work in rib until the knitting measures 14.5cm (measuring from the side edge not the centre).

Ruffle edge

Row 1: inc into every stitch [84sts]

Row 2: purl

Row 3: *k1, inc,* repeat to the end of the row [126sts]

Row 4: purl

Row 5: Col B knit one row

Cast off in Col B

Left mitten

Using Col A and 4mm needles cast on 42sts

K30, pm, k12

Knit 1 row

Continue in pattern as follows

Row 1: k17, inc, k10, skpo, sm, k2tog, k8, inc, k1

Row 2: knit

Row 3: Col B k2, *yo, skpo,* repeat to last 2 stitches, k2

Row 4: p2 *yo, p2tog,* repeat to last 2 stitches, p2

Row 5 and 6: Col A knit

Repeat these 6 rows until the knitting measures 9.5cm finishing after a **Row 2** and then complete the rib and ruffle edge as for **Right mitten**.

To make up Sew the side edges together leaving a gap for the thumb.
